It has been a lovely start to this half term. The children have started so positively and are working really hard. We are excited about our new push to be more sustainable through Climate Education.

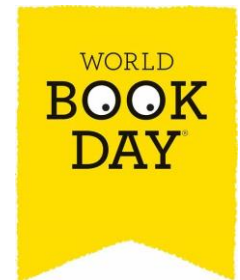
This will start with our Big Walk and Wheel organised by Mr Brough.
